

Getting to Oddfellows Hall

TRAINS AND BUSES

For journey planning visit www.traveline.org.uk. This website recognises the hall's postcode: BS8 2LT. Alternatively, phone Traveline on 0871 2002233 or National Rail Enquiries on 0845 7484950. As well as bus and rail links, both **Bristol Temple Meads** and **Bristol Parkway** train stations have taxi ranks. The journey from Parkway is about five miles and the journey from Temple Meads is about two miles.

To find **train services** to Clifton Down you will need to stipulate in your search on the traveline site that you are looking for trains only (i.e. exclude buses etc...) You will also need to check with National Rail Enquiries that the line is not closed for repairs on the date you are travelling.

DIRECTIONS FROM THE NEAREST BUS STOPS & TRAIN STATION

From the Belgrave Road bus stops on Whiteladies Road - about two minutes walk.

Walk away from the traffic lights, towards the zebra crossing and Belgrave Road. West Park is the second turning on the right. Oddfellow's Hall is half way down West Park on the right.

From the St Michaels Hill bus stops on Cotham Road - about two minutes walk.

From the mini roundabout walk down Cotham Hill, to the right of the Homoeopathic Hospital. West Park is the second turning on the left. Oddfellow's Hall is half way along West Park on the left.

From Clifton Down train station - about five minutes walk.

Take the exit from platform 1 onto Whiteladies Road. Turn right and walk south along Whiteladies Road for two or three minutes. Pass the first zebra-crossing you come to and cross the second one, directly in front of Whiteladies House. West Park is just to the right of Whiteladies House. West Park is the first turning on the left after the zebra-crossing. Oddfellow's Hall is half way along West Park on the right.
